

Additional Information:

To qualify for the benefits you must be actively enrolled in either EFC, PESS, Aftercare or ETV.

For incentive and assistance, the young adult must complete a request form.

The stimulus payments will be issued automatically to all Young Adults currently enrolled in EFC or PESS, no request is required.

The Chafee Program ends when the all funds have been disbursed or September 30, 2022, whichever occurs first.

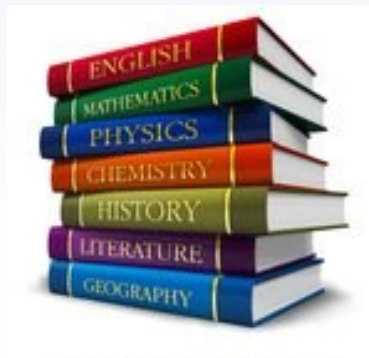
