MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Education / Experience / Certification

- ◆ A Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in social work or related field.
 - Official transcripts are a mandatory requirement
- ◆ A minimum of two (2) years of experience in Child Welfare is required, with an emphasis in foster care/adoption preferred.
- ◆ A Bachelor's Degree in psychology, social work, sociology or related human services degree and adoption experience may be substituted.

Certificates, License, Registrations, background checks, drug screens

- Valid driver's license required
- Driver's license check is required
- Drug Screening is required
- E-Verify (US Citizenship Verification) is required
- Criminal background screening mandatory (Local law enforcement and FBI/FDLE)
