MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Education / Experience / Certification

- A bachelor's degree from a four-year accredited college or university OR an advanced degree in social work or a comparable human service field
 > Official transcripts are a mandatory requirement.
- Must have a working knowledge of community services in the local five (5) county area.
- Motivational Interviewing skilled or willingness to complete training within 3 months of hiring.
- Trust-Based Relational Intervention trained or ability to complete training within 3 months of hiring.
- Adoption Competency training (preferred)

General Purpose of Job (Full job description will be provided upon interview)

To assist children and families who achieved guardianship or adoption through the Wendy's Wonderful Kids program maintain placement stability. Proactive contacts will be made with families to provide information on available services. As needs are identified, children and families will be linked timely to culturally competent post permanency support and case management services with providers who practice trauma informed care. Families will have opportunities to build their natural and informal support network by participating in monthly family support groups facilitated by this position.

Certificates, License, Registrations, background checks, drug screens

- Valid driver's license required, and clean driver's license check is required, with proof of insurance
- Drug Screening is required
- E-Verify (US Citizenship Verification) is required
- Criminal background screening mandatory (Local Law/FBI/FDLE)
- Child welfare certification within one
 (1) year of post-test
