- Stress Reduction: Our Navigators offer emotional support and stress management techniques to help caregivers cope with the demands of caregiving.
- Providing Information and Referrals: Kinship navigators
 can provide caregivers with information and referrals to
 local resources, services, and programs that can support
 their caregiving needs.
- Empowerment: By providing education, training, and support, Kinship Navigators empower caregivers to make informed decisions and take control of their children's care.
- Helping with Navigating the System: Kinship navigators
 can guide caregivers through the complex child welfare
 system, helping them understand the process and
 paperwork involved in caring for a child or youth.
- Stress Reduction: Our Navigators offer emotional support and stress management techniques to help caregivers cope with the demands of caregiving.
