Being a part of community with people of similar experiences can help to strengthen the bond amongst adoptive families. We encourage you to participate in our monthly adoption support group meetings.



Beginning in this newsletter we will have a featured section that provides information about resources and supports that may be beneficial for your family.

- The maintenance adoption subsidy may be negotiated up to 100% of the current statewide Level II foster care board rate. This request must be submitted in writing. If approved the effective date is the of the written request.
- Requests for an enhanced adoption subsidy must be submitted
 in writing with supporting documentation. In determining whether
 to grant the request, the Department shall consider the medical,
 behavioral, and therapeutic needs of your child at the time of the
 negotiation, as well as the projected long-term needs based on
 your child's needs. The maintenance adoption subsidy is not
 intended to cover services which can be obtained through family
 insurance, Medicaid, Children's Medical Services, medical
 subsidy, or through special education plans provided by the
 public school district.
- If you have any questions or wish to submit a maintenance adoption subsidy enhancement request, please contact your Post Adoption Case Manager.



All families who have adopted a child from Charlotte, Hendry, Glades, Collier, or Lee Counties have an assigned Post Adoption Case Manager. Your Case Manager is assigned at the time of your adoption finalization, and remains available to assist you and your family to navigate community resources until your child reaches 18 years of age. If you are unsure who is your assigned Post Adoption Case Manager, you can contact the Agency at (239) 226-1524, or email us at PostAdopt@cnswfl.org.
