## Level 1 Program for Kin Caregivers

- Figure 1/1/25, as a Level 1 Kin home, you will receive a board rate of:
  - o \$586.90 for ages 0-5
  - o \$601.94 for ages 6-12
  - \$704.56 for ages 13-17\*\*
    - \*\*In addition, the Level I licensed foster homes are now eligible for the 10% Supplemental Room & Board Rates, pursuant to s. 409.145, F.S., which calculates to an additional amount of \$70.46 being made to those Level I licensed foster homes where children, ages 13-17, are placed.

\*\*\* Important Note: Level 1 funding is effective from the date of licensure, not the date of placement in your home. Unfortunately, there is no back pay for Level 1 caregivers\*\*\*

- ➤ Level 1 Kin Caregivers will receive additional financial supports:
  - o Effective 7/1/22:
    - \$200 childcare stipend per month per child ages 0-5 (or school entry)
    - Annual back to school clothing allowance per child
      - \$200 (ages 0-4)
      - \$300 (ages 5-17)
  - o Effective 10/1/22:
    - \$30 per month diaper stipend per child ages 0-3

- Mileage reimbursement (\$0.445 per mile)
- ➤ Level 1 Kin Caregivers will remain the legal custodian of the child in their care.
- ➤ Children in Level 1 homes who close Permanent Guardianship (after 6 consecutive months of board payments) would be eligible to receive Guardianship Assistance Payments (GAP), starting at \$333/child, regardless of location (even outside state of Florida) through the child(ren)'s 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ➤ Children in the GAP program will be eligible for College Tuition and Fee Waivers.
- ➤ Children in the GAP program will remain eligible for Medicaid after case closure.
- ➤ Level 1 Kin Caregivers will receive additional supports such as:
  - o Kinship Specialist assigned to their home
  - Linkage to community resources
  - Educational Supports
